Grades 5 & 6 Immigration Museum Excursion Tuesday 24 October

Dear Parents / Carers,

As part of our History and Intercultural Capability studies this term we will be visiting the Immigration Museum.

Visiting the museum will enable students to understand the history of cultural diversity in Australia and reflect on how intercultural experiences influence attitudes, values and beliefs. Students will go on a self-directed tour of the museum to develop an understanding of the history and experience of immigration to Victoria and Australia. They will gain an appreciation of what immigration has brought to this country by completing the activities from the Passport in each gallery space.

We will be travelling by train from Bentleigh station. We will meet at the station at 8:45am to catch the 9:00am train. We will return to Bentleigh station by train by 3:15pm. If there are any changes to these times due to train delays we will notify the school office and your class reps will notify you.

Children are to be dressed in full school uniform and have a packed lunch, snack and water bottle with them in a small bag.

Total cost of excursion is \$7.00 for museum entry and train travel.
